Corflex's Environmental Commitment

Corflex is a national leader in designing and manufacturing ecological operable partitions. Corflex integrated certain environmental issues to its daily activities based on three guiding principles:

- **Legal Compliance**
Corflex commits to design, manufacture and install its products while conforming to all legal environmental requirements, as well as following ecological design codes.
- **Continuous improvement**
Corflex is continuously looking for ways to minimize its impact on the environment. Therefore, it created an environmental management system based on the ISO 14001 standards. These standards provide the necessary tools to create a corporate culture of continuous improvement.
- **Pollution Prevention**
Corflex created a four part environmental program:

Ecological Products	Manufacture operable partitions with limited impact on the environment;
Production Surplus	Ensure that Corflex's factory production surplus is recycled to its highest degree and production waste kept to a minimum;
Recycling	Increase recycled material use and simplify recycling for its employees and their families by encouraging them to bring in from their home anything that is hard to recycle such as batteries, motor oil, paint, etc. in order to send them to the proper recycling facilities;
Paperless	Find ways to reduce the quantity of paper used during its normal operations.

The recycling policy rests on the conviction that we all have to do our part in order to help the environment. We believe this initiative will help increase environmental consciousness and will lead to more responsible and sustainable actions.
